REP. ARCONTI APPOINTED TO STATE HOUSE LEADERSHIP TEAM

*Positions to include Chair of the Energy & Technology Committee
and membership on the Environment Committee, General Law
Committee*

HARTFORD— **State Representative David Arconti (D-Danbury)** was named Chair of the legislature’s Energy and Technology Committee on Thursday. He was also re-appointed as a member of the Environment Committee and General Law Committee.

The Energy and Technology Committee has cognizance on all matters relating to the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection, energy planning and activities.

“I am honored to serve as Chair of the Energy & Technology Committee and continue the great work the committee has done over the past sessions,” said **Rep. Arconti**, who previously served as a member of the committee. “I am eager to help shape Connecticut’s energy future for the better and continue moving the state forward.”
