WATERBURY LEGISLATORS ANNOUNCE MAJOR FUNDING FOR WATERBURY

Hartford – **Rep. Jeff Berger (D-Waterbury)** and **Rep. Geraldo Reyes Jr (D-Waterbury)** are pleased to announce the approval of funds to the City of Waterbury for transportation and rehabilitation of Liberty Hall.

“As House Chair of the Finance, Revenue and Bonding Committee, I continue to work to make sure Waterbury is well represented in Hartford,” **Rep. Berger** said. “The transportation dollars will go a long way to improving our infrastructure and promoting economic development.”

“I join Rep. Berger in sharing the good news for Waterbury on this state funding,” **Rep. Reyes** said. “St. Vincent DePaul Mission provides indispensable services throughout the city and I am sure this funding will allow them to continue the good work.”

Items for Waterbury include:

- \$1,192,064 for [St. Vincent DePaul Mission of Waterbury](#) for the rehabilitation of the 16 unit Liberty Hall on South Main Street
- \$2.5 million transportation funding
