


# **CT***Prepares* Overview

Connecticut's citizens can create interactive emergency kits, create customized family communications plans and can view preparation guides so they are more informed on what to do in an emergency.










## **Home Screen**

- Preparation Guides (Before/During/After)






## **Contacts Screen**

- Reporting Suspicious Activity






### **Resources Screen**

- Show Me Apps (assist with communication)






## **Newsroom Screen**

- Twitter






## I Am Safe Screen

The Weather Screen provides the weather information for your location. In addition, special weather statements for your area would be displayed.






## **Alerts Screen**
