FARMINGTON ELECTED OFFICIALS APPLAUD APPROVAL OF STREETSCAPE IMPROVEMENTS

\$1 million grant for sidewalk project

State Representatives **Mike Demicco (D- 21st District)** and **Tammy Exum (D- 19th District)** commend the approval of a \$1 million grant for sidewalk and streetscape improvements in Farmington.

The grant request was first submitted in 2018 and was subject to approval from the State Bond Commission, which voted via teleconference on Tuesday to support the project. The money will be put towards correcting cracked and uneven sidewalks in historic Farmington Village.

“This is great news for the Town of Farmington,” **Rep. Demicco** said. “For several years now, Rep. Exum and I have been looking forward to the approval of this project, which will greatly improve walking access for pedestrians. I am grateful to the State Bond Commission for approving these funds.”

“I wish to thank the State Bond Commission for approving this grant request for the people of Farmington,” said **Rep. Exum**. “These funds will now make it possible to fix many uneven portions of the sidewalk that have presented tripping hazards for people in recent years. This project will go a long way towards keeping this area of Farmington one of the most scenic parts of our town.”

According to the bond request, the project is expected to begin within the next 12 months.
