## REP. ROSE LAUDS VETO OVERRIDE OF REVISIONS TO 8-30G STATUTE

**HARTFORD** – Representative **Kim Rose (D-Milford)** lauds the legislature’s override of the Governor’s veto of a bi-partisan bill, [House Bill #6880](#), she championed in the House of Representatives which revises language in the affordable housing statute to protect towns and cities from predatory development while encouraging the development of affordable housing throughout the state.

“I thank my colleagues for recognizing the merits of this bill and acknowledging that we have problems with this law, especially in Milford,” **Rep. Rose** said. “The law is over 30 years old and not practical in today’s market and construction business. The governor was clearly out of touch with my constituents in Milford with his veto - he had not taken the time to understand how this law has negatively affected Milford.”

Rep. Rose is serving her fourth legislative term. She is co-chair of the Women’s Caucus, House vice chair of the legislature’s Housing Committee, Assistant Majority Whip and a member of the Internship and Veterans Affairs Committees.
