## CURREY APPOINTED TO TASK FORCE

**State Representative Jeff Currey (D-11)** has been named by House Speaker Brendan Sharkey (D-Hamden) to serve on the Efficiency Planning Task Force.

“Evaluating the efficiency of state services is an important task and I feel quite privileged to be selected as part of the process,” **Rep. Currey** said. “I look forward to working in a bipartisan manner to put forth the appropriate recommendations for the state.”

Speaker of the House Brendan Sharkey appointed Currey to this task force last Tuesday morning.

“Representative Currey’s experience on the legislature’s appropriations committee helps make him a good fit for this important task force, which is charged with finding new ways to ensure our tax dollars are used as efficiently as possible,” said Speaker of the **House Brendan Sharkey** (D-Hamden). “Our state budget demands a close scrutiny of all expenditures, and I’m confident in Rep. Currey’s ability to help us meet this challenge.”

The task force, which was created by the General Assembly in December 2015, was created to “identify and evaluate the efficiency of state services that, on average, cost the state more than \$250,000 per recipient annually to provide.”

The task force consists of eight General Assembly members, with an equal number of Democrat and Republican members.

The task force is scheduled to submit its report of recommendations by Dec. 8.

Rep. Currey represents the 11th Assembly District and serves on the Appropriations, Education, Insurance and Real Estate, and Judiciary Committees.
