STATE PROVIDES LAND FOR RIVERBEND PARK *Conroy: Parcel included in conveyance legislation*

State Representative **Theresa Conroy** (D-Seymour, Beacon Falls, Derby) announced the state has transferred a small piece of land to Beacon Falls to expand Riverbend Park. The transfer was included in the [Land Conveyance Bill](#) that was approved during the recent special session of the General Assembly.

“The Riverbend Park Committee did an incredible amount of work on this project. That made it easier for me to work with legislative leadership to make sure the land was included in this year’s conveyance,” Rep. Conroy said.

The legislation conveys a 0.22 acre parcel of land to the town of Beacon Falls for open space in return for administrative costs of the transaction.

Riverbend Park, located off of Lopus Road along the Naugatuck River offers river access for experienced kayakers and canoeists. The park is also a prime spot for trout fishing.

According to state land surveys, the property is bordered on the north by the Naugatuck River, south to south east by a highway line and Pines Bridge Road, Route No. 42 and on the east by a highway line.
