- Name of Award:** **Hartford Community Food Security Awards 2017**
- What:** In recognition of efforts to strengthen local food systems, improve nutrition, and empower communities to move toward long-term food security, with the goal of decreasing hunger in Hartford.
- Purpose:** To raise public awareness of community food security planning and programs by recognizing individuals and/or groups that demonstrate successful strategies to improve food security in Hartford.
- Eligibility:** Individuals (youth and adult), for profit groups, businesses, nonprofit groups, public service agencies, and government agencies.
- Criteria:** The Hartford Advisory Commission on Food Policy will select four award recipients, one for each of the following categories: *individual (adult)*, *individual (youth)*, *business/for profit organization*, and *nonprofit organization/public service/government agency*.
- Criteria for selection include the nominee's contribution in the areas of advocacy, education, emergency assistance, food access, food system planning, nutrition and health programs, outreach and partnerships between local farms and consumers that benefit Hartford. Selection of award recipients will be based on responses to questions on this nomination form and other submitted materials.**
