## REP. ALLIE-BRENNAN RECEIVES HIGH RANKS ON CONNECTICUT LEAGUE OF CONSERVATIVE VOTERS ENVIRONMENTAL SCORECARD

(HARTFORD, CT) – The Connecticut League of Conservative Voters (CTLCV) released the 2021 Environmental Scorecard which is meant to hold lawmakers accountable for their advocacy and commitment toward moving climate related legislation through the state legislature. **State Representative Allie-Brennan** (D-Bethel, Danbury, Newtown, Redding) scored 100% for his work in the 2021 Legislative Session, gaining recognizing for his support on issues such as energy efficient retrofit grant programs for affordable housing, wildlife trafficking, energy storage and mitigating climate change.

“I’m proud to receive a perfect score from the Connecticut League of Conservation Voters for my voting record in support of the most pressing environmental issues facing Connecticut families,” said **Representative Allie-Brennan**. “Communities throughout Connecticut are experiencing the effects of climate change, and it’s critically important that the legislature continues to take steps to protect the health of our environment and ensure the resiliency of our communities. I was proud to bring critical pieces of legislation to the House Floor last session, including An Act Concerning the Commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy Program, which offers businesses a tool to pay for zero-emission vehicle infrastructure and resiliency measures, to address the climate crisis. I’ll continue to work with my colleagues to advance legislation that protects the health of our air and water, combats pollution, and grows renewables.”
